

# Reaching Romania For Christ "Ye have not chosen me, but I have Ochosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit..." John 15:16

### Romania

Situated at the very center of the ancient spice routes of the Orient, Romania is a picturesque country with snow-capped mountains, agricultural plains, and coastal beaches. Located in Eastern Europe, Romania is bordered by Hungary, Serbia, Bulgaria, and Ukraine, as well as the Black Sea.



There are two distinct cultural groups in Romania: Romanians and Gypsies (or Roma). Originally from India, Gypsies spread throughout Europe over 1000 years ago and developed their own language and

culture. Gypsies have been persecuted throughout history.

Even today they face discrimination in employment, education, and healthcare. They are prohibited from attending Romanian Orthodox churches and are even told they have no souls. Most Gypsies are illiterate and poor.

## The Need in Romania

Since 1993, Baptist Mid-Missions missionaries have planted more than a dozen independent Baptist churches, primarily among the Gypsies. However, there is a tremendous need for more workers to help these young churches grow.

When we took a survey trip to Romania in March 2006, we witnessed many ministry opportunities with both the Romanians and the Gypsies. The Gypsy believers, in particular, pleaded with us to return and teach them about God and reach other Gypsies for the Lord.

## Our Burden for Romania

David has a burden for soul winning and men's ministries. He desires to see men saved and become leaders in their local church, so they can help win others to Christ. Ruth's desire is to teach the women and the children. Only a few of the Gypsy churches currently hold women's or children's classes.

- Church Planting Helping start Gypsy and Romanian churches
- Evangelism Personal evangelism and evangelism training
- Discipleship One-on-one and small group Bible studies
- Outreach Developing personal relationships with people
