We are thankful for the teens who are coming regularly each Thursday to Youth Group. We are currently averaging 15, with roughly the same number of boys and girls. The topic we chose for this quarter is Love, Courtship and Marriage, a very pertinent topic since many young people in the Roma culture



become involved in relationships at a much younger age than most Romanians and those from western European countries. We are hoping to help them understand from a Biblical perspective what true love is, and why it is important to

remain sexually pure until marriage. We are using material from Source of Light Ministries, which has been translated into Romanian.

We have been visiting in the community most Tuesdays, which has allowed us to meet some new people and to encourage them to worship with us. Pray that we can continue to connect with the parents of the young people and that they will make attending church a priority.
