Our teammates, the Warners, experienced the joy of the birth of Lucy. Likewise, 2012 was a year of new responsibilities and challenges in Luncsoara. God has been with us each step of the way. We have learned much about ourselves and ministry through these past five months especially through the ups and downs of church planting in the Gypsy culture. Even the Gypsies acknowledge the difficulty of this work, be it the poverty, or the gossip, or the lack of unity in the home and community. Satan continues to find ways to impede the work, but we know he cannot stop it.

We are thankful for the help we have had from our teammates, Tim Fink and Travis Gravley, as they have been preaching on Thursdays, which has freed Dave's time to focus on Sundays.

Christmas was clearly the most challenging time this year with numerous activities. Add to that, hours connected with the property purchase, and it made for a stressful time.



On Christmas Day Ruth directed the children's program and gave a gift package to each child that participated. Over 20 adults attended (mostly visitors), and 73 children received packages. That program was followed by our adult service with even more visitors. After the service we had a special meal prepared mostly by Tarzan and Amalia. Imagine preparing a four-course meal for 30 people over a small woodburning stove!

Property Update

It's been a long journey with the property, but we were able to sign a provisional contract in early December until the owner secures the remaining documents. We hope to to finish the purchase in January. Unfortunately the buildings were not legally transacted previously (long story), so they will need to be torn down. Continue to pray for wisdom in this process and for our church family to remain patient. They are anxious to get working on things, which would provide some income during the long winter months. However, we are not ready to begin any work until we have the final contract.
